This course covers management of a production operating environment, including use of the Command Line Interface (CLI) capabilities. This course is designed for experienced network and server administrators.

- Understand the Netvisor OS architecture, operating environment and functionalities
- Perform a hands-on install of the Netvisor OS on a bare metal Open Networking switch
- Configure, provision and manage Netvisor OS-powered open switches
- Implement and provision an Adaptive Cloud Fabric architecture for single or multi-location environments
- Leverage the embedded telemetry of Netvisor OS to monitor network performance using CLI
- An introduction to the Pluribus UNUM Management, Automation and Analytics platform and the Pluribus Insight Analytics performance management platform

Pluribus Management and Analytics Platforms and Administration

This three-hour live online instructor-led course teaches the fundamentals of the Pluribus UNUM Management, Automation and Analytics platform. The course will cover all aspects of the Pluribus UNUM platform, including device management, the Fabric Manager, topology maps, and Insight Analytics modules. Students will learn how to successfully install, configure, and operate these automation and analytics capabilities in context with a production network environment. This course is designed for network administrators. Prior Netvisor OS knowledge is not required.

At the end of this course you will be able to:

- Understand the Pluribus UNUM Management platform, including the architecture and modules
- Download, install and configure a Pluribus UNUM system from scratch
- Leverage the topology maps to understand network flows and streamline troubleshooting
- Monitor and analyze network traffic from SPAN ports or from inline deployments
- Perform Flow and Packet analysis activities, including real-time drill-down analysis
- Leverage historical data records to perform historical troubleshooting and forensics analysis
